Sally Kane Memorial Scholarship

Sally-Cotton-Kane championed many causes. She attended Butler University where she majored in dance. In 1976 she moved to New Jersey and returned to Indiana in 1983, entering into the insurance business. In 2004 she joined husband Chuck in owning and operating Lucky Strike Lanes in Elwood, Indiana. Her passion in bowling was centered on youth and education. She worked tirelessly behind the scenes mentoring and focusing on the importance of family and how bowling was relative as the true family pastime.

She refused to let a 2006 diagnosis of breast cancer dampen her resolve. Motivated by her positive attitude, she continued to maintain her active lifestyle and set the bar high for all who knew her. She contended that anything is possible if we believe we are capable of doing it.

Sally died January 24, 2013. Her memory will live on through the scholarships awarded annually by the Indiana Bowling Centers Association dedicated in her name.

This Scholarship is awarded annually to five Indiana USBC High School Bowlers who bowl in an IBCA member center.

The **Sally Kane Memorial Scholarship** annually recognizes (up to 5) USBC Youth Bowlers for their community involvement and academic achievements. Up to five winners will be chosen and awarded a \$1000 Scholarship at the Classic Products Trade Show, Summer 2020.

The Indiana Bowling Centers Association presents this prestigious scholarship in honor of the late Sally Kane. Sally was dedicated to helping youth bowlers and the IBCA is proud to continue these efforts in her name.

Eligibility and Requirements: Must include all listed requirements below or application will be denied.

- 1. Must be a participant in the IBCA High School Bowling Program.
- 2. Must be from an IBCA member bowling center.
- 3. Must be an USBC Youth member.
- 4. Must reside in the state of Indiana.
- 5. Must have a current GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale.
- 6. Completed application, including 500 word essay

- 7. Include a head shot photo on disk or thumb drive.
- 8. Include at least one letter of reference by a teacher, principal, employer, etc.
- Return all completed documentation and application to IBCA post marked no later than May 1, 2020.
